Don’t Rush Your Smile: Patients Beware of Permanent Teeth Following Implant Surgery

According to dental research, four to six months is the proper healing period before attaching permanent teeth to dental implants. Implant centers that advertise next-day permanent teeth may be giving patients unrealistic expectations—and putting the results of their treatment at risk.

“Full-force chewing without proper healing can lead to catastrophic implant failure,” says Dr. Ilya Benjamin. “I don’t cut corners or rush this lifetime investment.” Dr. Benjamin wisely waits for biology to take its due time to ensure healing and to give his patients a successful, long-lasting outcome.

Knowledgeable and Experienced

Dr. Benjamin has undertaken postgraduate training at Mount Sinai Hospital. He also has advanced training in zygomatic implants and is licensed to provide IV conscious sedation.

He has two decades of experience using dental implants to help patients suffering from failing or missing teeth. Digital Smile Design

During a complimentary consultation, patients are able to see a preview of how

their new smile will look before any work is done in their mouth. "We design the teeth virtually on the computer so the patient can see the end result before we've begun," says Dr. Benjamin. "They can then approve it or give us feedback on what changes they want to see. That way, we make sure the patient will be totally satisfied with their new smile from the very start. Patients appreciate that."

High-Tech 3D Planning

Dr. Benjamin uses the latest technology and an all-digital workflow to ensure the New Teeth in One Day procedure is precise, efficient and minimally invasive for his patients. A CT scan of the patient's mouth and jaw shows Dr. Benjamin their oral anatomy in a detailed 3D X-ray. Dr. Benjamin uses this data in special implant planning software to simulate the entire procedure ahead

of time. He then 3D prints a surgical guide that indicates the precise locations, angles and depths for placing the implants as determined in the software.

One-Day Procedure

On the day of the surgery, Dr. Benjamin sedates the patient, extracts any remaining teeth, places the implants using the custom surgical guide and attaches a temporary arch of new teeth—all in one visit.

"Patients come in with their mouth in bad shape and leave that day with a great new smile they want to show off," says Dr. Benjamin.

Minimally Invasive, Comfortable Treatment

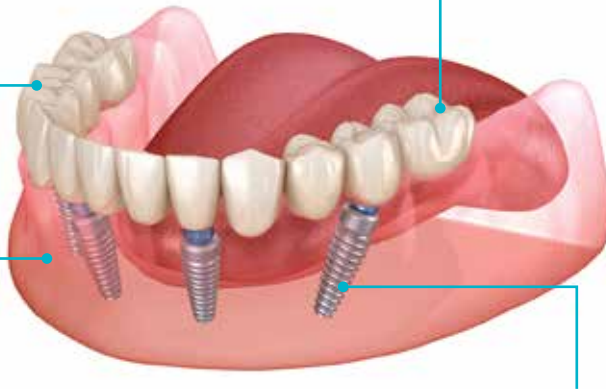
As a result of Dr. Benjamin's precise digital planning and use of custom surgical guides, the implant placement is minimally

Up Close With **NEW TEETH IN ONE DAY**

The teeth are made into one unit (a dental "bridge") so the load is evenly distributed and chewing power is strong.

The final teeth are made of strong and natural-looking zirconia. They are permanently fixed in place and will not come loose, shift or move around in the mouth.

Four implants are strategically placed in areas with an adequate volume of dense bone for maximum support. This often eliminates the need for any bone grafting.



The implants are placed at an angle to increase bone-to-implant contact and provide strong support for the new teeth.

What Is a **Dental Implant**?

A dental implant is an artificial tooth root made of titanium that is designed to replace a missing or extracted tooth. It is placed in the jawbone, and a dental crown, bridge or denture is attached.



invasive, and patients experience fast healing as a result. Also, because patients are sedated for the procedure, they comfortably sleep through it and wake up afterward with their temporary new teeth fixed firmly in place.

Dedicated to Lasting Results

Dr. Benjamin takes the time to ensure the implants have fused with the bone before placing the patient's permanent teeth.

"Recently, new implant centers in Las Vegas are promising permanent teeth the next day after surgery," he says. "It may sound tempting, but we want to make sure that patients understand the potential risks and complications associated with such a short waiting period. We don't want to endanger our patients' new teeth or the investment they have made in their dental health."

Most research in dental implants shows

that a healing period of at least four to six months is needed to avoid increased risk of implant failure, infection and gum disease, poor aesthetics and overall compromised function.

Beautiful New Teeth

Dr. Benjamin works with Dr. Gallardo to design the patient's final teeth. Once the implants have been given the time they need to fully integrate with the patient's jawbone, they replace the temporary denture with a beautiful, strong and durable permanent bridge of new teeth.

The final bridge is handcrafted in their in-house dental lab by skilled lab technicians who make sure it looks, fits and functions just right. The teeth are made of zirconia, an extremely strong and durable, natural-looking material that won't fade and looks just like real teeth.

Ready To DITCH YOUR DENTURES?



Ill-fitting, always-shifting dentures not only keep patients from enjoying their favorite foods, but have a sneaky way of stealing their confidence and diminishing their health, appearance and quality of life. Dr. Benjamin provides implant-supported New Teeth in One Day, allowing patients to overcome the shortcomings of dentures and giving them a confident, natural-looking smile and full chewing power.

Until recently, the default treatment for someone needing to replace all of their missing or failing teeth (all upper or lower teeth—known as a “full arch”) was a removable denture. As long-time denture wearers know, this is far from an ideal solution. Fortunately, Dr. Benjamin offers a vastly superior option with New Teeth in One Day.

The Problems With Dentures

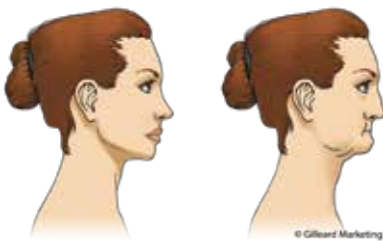
Traditional dentures have many disadvantages. To begin with, they provide only around 10% of natural chewing power, which usually results in a restricted diet and/or digestive problems caused by under-chewed food. Messy adhesive is required to keep dentures in place, yet they can still shift or fall out, causing embarrassment. Dentures constantly lose their fit and rub against the gums, making chewing painful and causing sores. Upper dentures require a false palate that impedes a person’s ability to fully taste the foods they enjoy.

Additionally, bone loss occurs in the jawbone when teeth are missing, and the use of dentures accelerates this process, eventually leading to a prematurely aged appearance (see illustration below).

Implant-Supported New Teeth in One Day Are the Solution

Because New Teeth in One Day are supported by dental implants placed in the jawbone, patients do not experience any of these issues. Being anchored to implants, the new teeth will never slip or fall out, and there is no need for a false upper palate.

The implants stimulate the jawbone to keep it strong and prevent bone loss. They also restore near-natural chewing power, enabling Dr. Benjamin’s patients to comfortably eat the foods they enjoy and need for proper nutrition.



Bone loss occurs as a result of leaving teeth unreplaced, even when wearing an old-fashioned denture. Without the stimulation provided by full-force chewing, the jaw bone gradually disappears. Wearing dentures intensifies this process due to the constant friction of the denture on

the bony ridge. Eventually, so much bone is lost that the lower part of the face collapses in on itself. The chin moves toward the nose, and the mouth and cheeks sink in, causing deep wrinkles and folds.

Unstable Dentures

- Dentures slip and move and can come out while talking or eating.
- Goopy, messy adhesive is needed to try and keep dentures in place.
- Upper dentures require a false palate to help keep them in place. This inhibits the wearer's ability to fully taste and enjoy their food.
- A weak bite means poor chewing ability and a restricted diet.
- Denture teeth are made of plastic and look bulky and unnatural.
- Bone loss occurs when teeth are missing, and dentures accelerate this process, resulting in the eventual collapse of the facial structure (see the illustration on page 6).

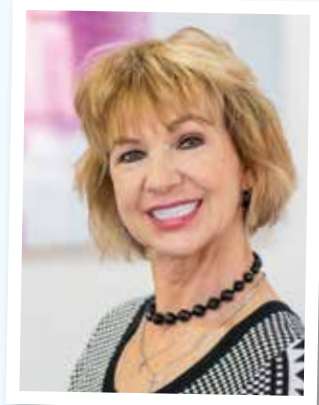

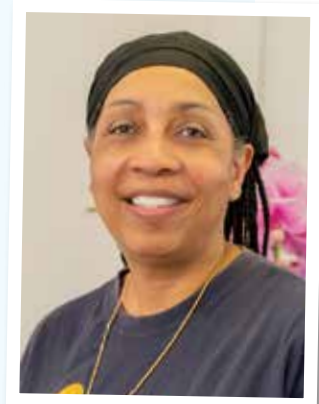

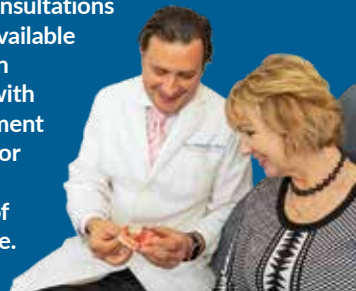

1 COMPLIMENTARY CONSULTATION

Patients are given a warm welcome upon arriving for their complimentary consultation. Dr. Benjamin and his staff are known for their friendly, caring and personable manner.



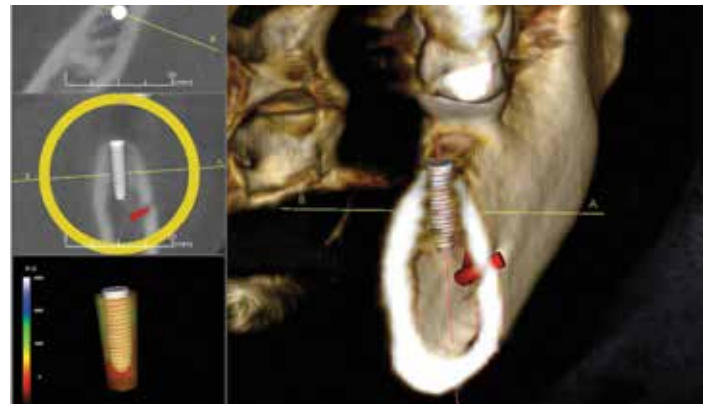
2 SAME-DAY DIAGNOSTICS

If they wish, patients can get their diagnostics done the same day; this includes a 3D CT scan that allows Dr. Benjamin to see their entire oral anatomy in a 360-degree X-ray.



3 DIGITAL PREVIEW

Within 48 hours, the patient receives a digital preview of their new smile. They can then request any changes to it before moving ahead.



4 HIGH-TECH 3D PLANNING

Dr. Benjamin does extensive planning using special 3D software. He simulates the procedure in advance on the computer to ensure there are no surprises during the actual procedure.



5 IMPLANT PLACEMENT

On the day of the procedure, Dr. Benjamin removes any remaining teeth, places a minimum of four dental implants in the patient's jaw and attaches aesthetic and functional temporary teeth.



6 A BEAUTIFUL NEW SMILE

Once the implants sites have fully healed, the patient returns to have their beautiful final teeth permanently attached. Dr. Benjamin makes sure the patient is completely happy with their new smile.

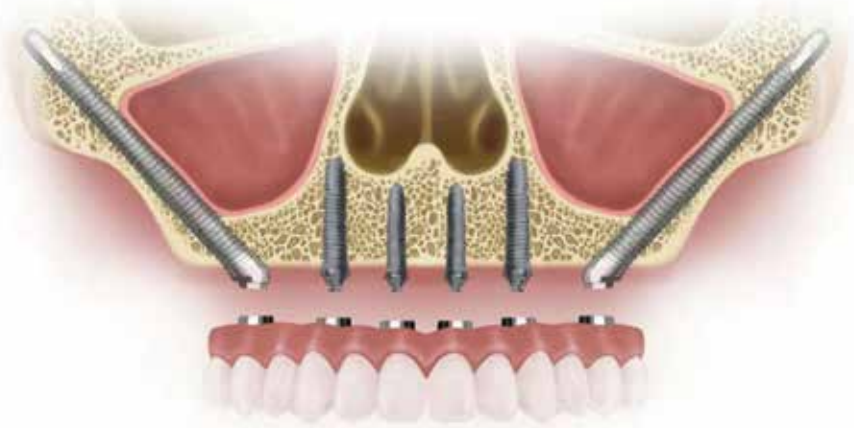

Been Told You Have Too Little Bone for Dental Implants? **MAYBE NOT...**

Dr. Benjamin frequently sees patients who have lost a lot of their jawbone density due to long-term missing teeth and traditional denture usage. In the past, patients such as these would have been considered unfit candidates for implant treatment, but, thanks to Dr. Benjamin's talent, skill and use of state-of-the-art dental techniques, that is no longer the case. Dr. Benjamin offers bone grafting to build up and restore lost jawbone, as well as graftless techniques—including using long, angled implants and special zygomatic implants—that allow his patients to receive successful and lasting dental implant treatment.



Zygomatic implants use the patient's cheekbone to provide a stable foundation for implant placement.

Restoring Lost Bone With Bone Grafting

Lost jawbone can be rebuilt and restored with bone grafting. Dr. Benjamin surgically adds graft material to the area of deficient bone. This material boosts the density of the area and acts as a kind of scaffold for new bone growth.

As part of his grafting treatment, Dr. Benjamin incorporates the use of natural growth factors that speed healing and minimize discomfort for the patient (see page 13).

Avoid Extensive Bone Grafting With New Teeth in One Day

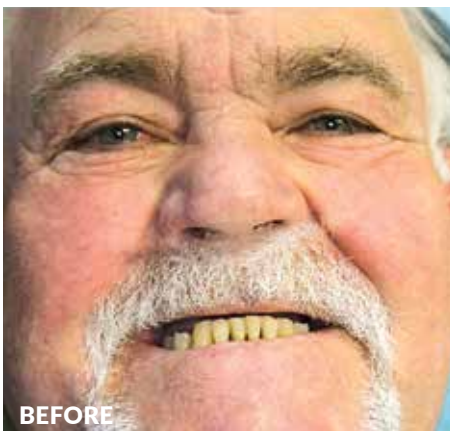
The New Teeth in One Day procedure uses longer-than-usual implants placed at an angle to maximize contact with the densest areas of available jawbone. As a result, the need for bone grafting is drastically reduced or, in many cases, completely eliminated.

Zygomatic Implants

For people who are lacking bone in the upper back of their mouth—a condition frequent among long-term

denture wearers—Dr. Benjamin offers zygomatic implants. Zygomatic implants are long enough to reach and integrate with the patient's zygomatic (cheek) bone for the needed stabilization. "A perk of zygomatic implants is that their foundation is so strong that the patient can start putting pressure on them immediately after they are placed," says Dr. Benjamin. "This means I can affix new teeth right away that are immediately functional."

FULL-MOUTH REHABILITATION

Even the most run-down mouth can be restored to full health, function and beauty with a full-mouth rehabilitation. Dr. Benjamin and Dr. Gallardo provide fully customized treatment that not only results in an attractive smile, but one that is comfortable, stable and healthy.

Dr. Benjamin and Dr. Gallardo know that replacing all of a patient's teeth may not always be the best solution. They see many patients who have failing dental work, or who want a life-enhancing smile redesign, that can be better served with a full-mouth rehabilitation.

"Unlike at a national dental chain where every patient gets the same rubber stamp treatment, everything we do is custom-tailored to each patient to fit their individual needs," says Dr. Benjamin. "We're not going to give a full arch of new teeth to someone who doesn't need it. Some people can get the results they need with a full-mouth rehabilitation."

Customized Care

A full-mouth rehabilitation consists of a combination procedures that create a healthy, aesthetic and functional smile. The doctors can restore damaged or decayed teeth with crowns or repair them with root canals. Unsaveable teeth can be gently extracted and replaced with dental implants. Treatment may also include gum disease treatment or improving the patient's bite, or purely cosmetic procedures, such as veneers, to improve the color and shape of existing teeth.

Knowledgeable and Experienced Dentists

Drs. Benjamin and Gallardo have helped hundreds of patients restore their smiles with full-mouth rehabilitation. As a prosthodontist, Dr. Gallardo has been trained to handle even the most complex cases. Both doctors are skilled in all the procedures that could be involved in full-mouth rehabilitation treatment.

The Full-Mouth Rehabilitation Process

Detailed diagnostic work, including using an intraoral scanner and 3D CT scanner, is done to determine what procedures are necessary. Patients get to see a digital simulation of their new smile prior to treatment and can wear a temporary, 3D-printed version of their new smile to make sure they like how it looks and feels.

The doctors then perform the full-mouth rehabilitation, and patients get to enjoy the many benefits of the treatment, including full chewing ability and a more youthful and confident smile.

Taking Care of Your Teeth **KEEP A HEALTHY SMILE FOR LIFE**

Regular dental cleanings do more than just give patients a bright and shiny new smile—they also help ensure that their teeth and gums stay healthy. At Dr. Benjamin's office, patients can get thorough routine cleanings with a state-of-the-art dental laser.

"We take great care in being gentle, friendly and informative with our exams and cleanings," says skilled hygienist Lauren. "We explain about the health of the patient's teeth and gums and use a gentle laser to remove bacteria, followed by at-home care instructions to help them keep their teeth in tip-top shape."

The Benefits of Laser-Assisted Hygiene Treatment

To maximize the effectiveness of routine dental cleanings, Lauren uses a high-quality Nd:Yag laser (see page 13) to remove the bacteria that cause gum disease, bone loss and bad breath. The laser destroys dangerous bacteria without harming healthy tissue, leaving Lauren's patients with clean teeth and a healthy smile.

State-of-the-Art TECHNOLOGY

Dr. Benjamin has equipped his practice with many of the latest advances in digital dental technology in order to provide precise, efficient and comfortable teeth replacement for his patients.

Dr. Benjamin uses the PiC dental imaging system to quickly and accurately determine the correct position in which to place the implants for New Teeth in One Day, giving the replacement teeth a precise fit.



A digital impression scanner allows Dr. Benjamin to capture 3D impressions of patients' teeth. This is far more accurate and comfortable than old-style impressions made with impression putty.



The RAYFace facial scanner uses six high-resolution cameras that operate simultaneously to take a realistic 3D facial scan to be used with CAD/CAM dental software. "The RAYFace technology gives us the 'golden proportions' of the face," says Dr. Benjamin. "We use the images it produces to perform smile design and create custom restorations that perfectly suit the patient's own unique features."

In-House DENTAL LAB

With his own dental lab located right in his office, Dr. Benjamin is able to closely oversee the creation of his patients' new teeth and ensure they meet his high standards. "A lot of dental offices outsource work to labs that are far away, and it is harder to control the final outcome that way," says Dr. Benjamin. "We do everything right here and make sure patients get the most natural and aesthetically appropriate look, whether they want a 'Hollywood smile' or just want us to match their other teeth. Having my own lab also means that my patients get their new teeth faster, and there's a big cost-savings we pass on to the patient as well."

High-Quality Same-Day Crowns

Dr. Benjamin can even create new crowns in as little as 20 minutes—no need to wear a temporary crown and wait weeks for the final tooth to come from an outside lab.

Dr. Benjamin's crowns are made of translucent, multilayer zirconia for a beautiful, natural appearance. Thanks to his revolutionary high-speed sintering furnace, he can create and deliver strong, long-lasting crowns that fit perfectly and look great—all in one visit.

Dr. Benjamin's lab is stocked with the latest technologies, including a dental sintering furnace (far right) that heats and compresses the zirconia to reduce its porosity; a 3D printer (right) for creating custom surgical guides and temporary teeth from digital data; and a wet/dry milling machine (left) that creates the new teeth for New Teeth in One Day.



Growth Factors for FASTER HEALING

Whenever bone grafting is needed to establish a sturdy foundation for placing implants, Dr. Benjamin has a trick up his sleeve to speed healing and improve patient comfort. He takes a small amount of the patient's blood and spins it in the practice's centrifuge. This separates out platelet-rich fibrin (PRF), which is a naturally occurring growth factor. When applied to the graft site, PRF strengthens the existing jawbone in the area, reduces inflammation and accelerates the body's natural healing process.

PRF also has other handy uses; Dr. Benjamin can inject it into the gums to prevent patients who are on blood thinners from bleeding after a tooth extraction.

A centrifuge separates out platelet-rich fibrin from a small amount of the patient's blood.

Gentle and Effective DENTAL LASER TREATMENT

Dr. Benjamin's high-tech toolbox also includes a state-of-the-art dental laser. The Nd:Yag laser is used for treating gum disease—often in conjunction with a full-mouth rehabilitation—and to provide maintenance cleanings and routine hygiene.

If a patient has gum disease, Dr. Benjamin uses the laser to treat it thoroughly and gently without the need for cutting or sutures. The laser is minimally invasive, selectively targeting diseased tissue while leaving healthy tissue unaffected. It also stimulates the body's natural healing and regenerative potential, which assists in the repair of bone and gum tissue that may have been lost due to the disease.

Faster Healing

Healing time is much quicker with the laser than with conventional gum surgery. Instead of weeks, there's usually a less-than-24-hour recovery period, and most patients feel comfortable enough to eat when they get home after the procedure.

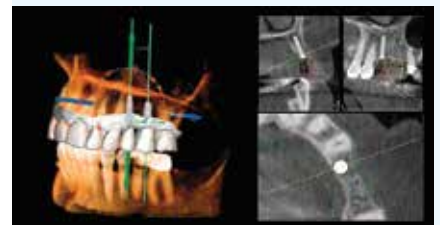
The laser can also be used for routine cleanings. Lauren, the registered dental hygienist at Dr. Benjamin's practice, is certified in the use of the laser for dental hygiene (see page 11).

Dr. Gallardo is a prosthodontist—a specialist in creating aesthetic dental restorations such as crowns, bridges, dentures and veneers. Dr. Benjamin completed a mini residency under a prosthodontist, enhancing his skills in creating long-lasting restorations that fit seamlessly with the patient’s teeth and face.

Custom Smile Design With Digital and 3D Technology

After an exam and consultation to discuss the patient’s goals, the doctors take photos and get accurate digital impressions. As needed, they use their RAYFace facial scanner to create a 3D image of the patient’s face, which is then combined with CAD/CAM smile design software. “This scan helps us determine

the ‘golden proportions’ of the face so we can design the perfect restoration,” says Dr. Benjamin. He and Dr. Gallardo may also create a digital wax-up for the patient to see and approve before beginning treatment.

Aesthetic Crowns and Veneers

The doctors use porcelain crowns or veneers to permanently whiten yellowed or discolored teeth, correct tooth shape, cover chips or fix mildly crooked teeth. The beautiful, lifelike restorations are custom designed and fabricated in the practice’s on-site dental lab, giving the doctors complete control over the quality and every detail of the aesthetics, such as tooth size, shape and shade.
